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#### 8. GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

Mr. Amorelli presented his verbal report encompassing operations, maintenance, projects and other District matters for the month of October, 2024, as follows:

### **OPERATIONS**

- Water Deliveries: October, 2024 Water deliveries for the month of October were 3,394 acre-feet which is 410 acre-feet more than was delivered during October, 2023. The fiscal year-to-date total deliveries are at 47,252 acre-feet which is 4,679 acre-feet more than was delivered at this time during the last fiscal year.
- Weekly TDS Readings: November 4, 2024
- Kings River Water Association (KRWA)
  - <u>KRWA Storage Operations in Pine Flat Reservoir</u> as of September 30, 2024, totaled 7,893 CFS-days.

### **AGENCIES**

- Fresno Irrigation District (FID) Met with FID representatives on October 21<sup>st</sup> to review 2024 operations and explored ways in which improvements might be made. Both agreed that keeping lines of communication open is extremely important.
- ► <u>Kings River Water Quality Coalition (KRWQC</u>) Met October 15<sup>th</sup> and discussed nitrate issues.

# **EVENTS**

Association of California Water Agencies, Region 6 & 7 - Attended the meeting at Harris Ranch on October 11<sup>th</sup> which was well attended. Roundtable discussion on SGMA, regulatory impacts and climate change affecting the Central Valley. Mr. Amorelli noted it to be a positive networking experience.

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#### 9. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent, Kenneth Mancini, reported on the following activities.

- Weir repairs (gates, boards, voids)
- Maintenance of banks/levees
- Spraying, mowing
- Repairing leaky headgates
- Well Repairs
- Constructing new discharges on pumps
- ▶ New well chemical treatments for reducing calcification were found to be successful, resulting in a 30-50% increase in yield.
